## Guidelines for Applications

### how to nominate

- Select the award category you think best suits the individual/organisation.
- Complete the Nomination Form and include contact details of both the individual/organisation being nominated and the person who is nominating them.
- A statement must be included addressing each award criteria (to a maximum of 500 words per criteria).
- Where possible supporting documentation can be included with your application (media, previous rewards and recognition).
- Please ensure no original documents are submitted as documentation will not be returned.
- Letter of support from an external party to be included with the nomination.
- Nominations may be received by post (see below) or via email [iccwa@iccwa.org.au](mailto:iccwa@iccwa.org.au). Acknowledgement of receipt should be received within 5 working days.
- All nominations must be received on or before the specified closing date.

### additional information

- Nominees selected as finalists for each category will be contacted at the completion of the judging process.
- All nominees or a representative are required to attend the Awards presentation ceremony on **Thursday 4th August 2011**.
- All nominees need to agree to participate in any media interviews or photographic opportunities where possible, and that these will be used to promote community safety issues. All winners will be widely promoted through local media.



### the judging process

- A judging panel of injury prevention and community safety peers coordinates an assessment process.
- All received entries are reviewed and a recommended short list is compiled.
- One winner is selected in each category.

### key dates

- **Entries Close** at 5.00pm on Friday 8th July 2011.
- **Winners announced** at the ICCWA Community Safety Awards ceremony on Thursday 4th August 2011.
