HOW TO NOMINATE

- Select the award category you think best suits your project.
- A nomination form must be completed which includes contact details of the individual/organisation being nominated, details of the person providing a letter of support, and a name and contact details for an additional verbal referee. All nominations are treated confidentially.
- A statement must be included addressing each award criteria. Limit the response for each criteria to less than 500 words, using available evidence, the achievements of the project, service or individual.
- In addition, please enclose or attach any extra information including photos, testimonials or clippings which supports the nomination.
- Please ensure no original documents are submitted as documentation will not be returned.
- All nominations must be received on or before the specified closing date.
- Nominations may be sent via post or email and acknowledgement of receipt should be received within 5 working days.
- All short-listed finalists will be officially notified of their selection and will be required to attend the Awards presentation.

Media and Promotion

Award recipients agree to participate in media and promotions relating to the awards including interviews, photographic opportunities where possible, and that these will be used to promote community safety issues. All winners will be widely promoted through local media.

Judging

- A panel of injury prevention and community safety peers coordinates an assessment process.
- Judges can consider entries in more than one category.
- The final decision of the judges will at all times be binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
