- ☀ Organise forums and seminars on hot safety topics of local interest
- ☀ Organise community events such as pram strolls, bicycle and motorised scooter rides, fun runs and walks in parks and on bicycle paths
- ☀ Distribute flyers and leaflets that promote safety messages
- ☀ Conduct safety audits of homes, workplaces, child care centres and shopping centres
- ☀ Prepare safety displays for shopping centres
- ☀ Launch safety projects and campaigns
- ☀ Run practical safety workshops, eg how to fit car restraints, making parks friendly for all ages
- ☀ Partner with like-minded organisations to promote safety
- ☀ Invite local celebrities and sporting identities to attend your events to promote safety messages
- ☀ Create an open day event to give people an 'inside look' at the safety measures you have in place
- ☀ Promote CSM in newsletters and on your website
