Public Transport Authority: On the Right Track

The Public Transport Authority's *Right Track* program encourages responsible and safe travel on Western Australia's public transport system and aims to inform and engage young people by promoting the "stay off the tracks" message. This hard hitting campaign alerts young people to the dangers and consequences of trespass and anti-social behaviour on and around trains, buses, train stations and interchanges.

The schools program is aimed at young people aged 11 – 16 years however program officers are also interested in engaging with young people aged 17 – 25 and promoting the safe and responsible use of public transport.

Wes Buzza will present an overview to the *Right Track* program and discuss the issue of irresponsible behaviour around trains and how to stay safe on public transport.

Wes Buzza, Community Education Officer at the Public Transport Authority is responsible for the ongoing development and coordination of the *Right Track* program. Wesley has previously spent 19 years as a primary school teacher with the Department of Education and Training Western Australia, teaching at all year levels. He also has many years experience as a volunteer with a variety of community organisations.
